LOIS K. COHEN, PHD

National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research, Retired.

Consultant and Paul G. Rogers Ambassador for Global Health Research, Dr. Cohen is formerly Associate Director for International Health, National Institute of Dental & Craniofacial Research at the National Institutes of Health. Her PhD. in sociology was earned at Purdue University (1963) where she also received an Honorary Doctorate of Letters (1989), the first sociologist ever to have been awarded that honor from Purdue. During her more than 58-year career having had Visiting Faculty appointments at both Howard University and Harvard University, she spent most of those years with the U.S. Government both as a researcher and a health science administrator. She edited and authored four volumes on the social sciences and dentistry and publishing more than 150 professional journal articles. Purported to be the architect of the behavioral and socio-dental sciences, she co-directed two major multinational collaborative studies with the World Health Organization on nationally developed oral health care delivery systems.

Dr. Cohen has served or currently serves on various organizational boards including: Foundation Against HIV/AIDS in Africa, the Journal of the American Dental Association, the Friends of the Organization of Safety, Aespsis and Prevention, the Edward B. Shils Entrepreneurial Fund, The Alliance for Oral Health across Borders, the Caplin Family Charities, the Regulatory Affairs Society's Global Advisory Council, Humble Smile Foundation, and the Institute of Musculoskeletal Health and Arthritis of the Canadian Institutes for Health Research. She regularly serves as an expert consultant to the World Health Organization in Geneva, its regional offices in the Americas (Pan American Health Organization) and the African region as well as various universities and associations focusing on global health through oral health.

Awards and/or honorary lectures in her name are given annually at Harvard School of Dental Medicine, the International Association for Dental Research and at the University of the Sciences (now merged with St. Joseph's University) in Philadelphia and at Purdue University.

RENA N. D'SOUZA, DDS, MS, PHD

Director, National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research

Dr. Rena D'Souza is the Director of the National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research, National Institutes of Health. She is deeply committed to the organization's mission — advance fundamental knowledge about dental, oral, and craniofacial health and disease and translate these findings into prevention, early detection, and treatment strategies that improve overall health for all individuals and communities across the lifespan.

As the director of NIDCR, Dr. D'Souza oversees the institute's annual budget of over \$500 million, supporting basic, translational, and clinical research in areas of oral cancer, orofacial pain, tooth decay, periodontal disease, salivary gland dysfunction, and the craniofacial development and the oral complications of systemic diseases. Prior to becoming NIDCR's director, Dr. D'Souza served at the University of Utah as Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs and Education for the Health Sciences. She held the Ole and Marty Jensen endowed chair in the School of Dentistry that she led as inaugural dean. As a clinicianscientist, D'Souza has been strongly committed to discovery and mentoring throughout her academic career. She is past president of the American Association for Dental Research (AADR) and the International Association for Dental Research (IADR).

Dr. D'Souza is an internationally recognized researcher and has authored over 150 publications and book chapters in the areas of craniofacial development, matrix biology and tissue regeneration for over 30 years. She is a Fellow of AAAS and also of AADR. She received the 2010 Presidential Award for Research Excellence from the Texas A&M Health Science Center and was inducted into the German National Academy of Sciences in 2012. Columbia University College of Dental Medicine's awarded Dr. D'Souza the Birnberg Research Medal in 2016. She also received the IADR Distinguished Scientist Award in Pulp Biology Research in 2002 and the Irwin D. Mandel Distinguished National Mentoring Award in 2017.

Dr. D'Souza is active on several trans-NIH committees and maintains an active research laboratory in the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD), NIH

Michael Monopoli, DMD, MPH, MS, serves as vice president for grant strategy for the CareQuest Institute for Oral Health. DR. WARDAH INAM

Dr. Wardah Inam is the Co-Founder and CEO of Overjet. Overjet is the leading provider of AI technology for the dental industry to help improve patient care.

Prior to founding Overjet, she led product development at a health care startup, Q Bio, working on biomedical imaging. Before that, she was a Postdoctoral Fellow at MIT Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence Lab, where she worked on remote biomedical sensing using machine learning on wireless signals.

Dr. Inam received a PhD from MIT, where she developed AI-powered microgrid technology. This work received widespread recognition including National Geographic covering it as a breakthrough that could transform the way we power the world. She has corporate experience from GE and Apple and is the recipient of the MIT Graduate Women of Excellence Award.

Dr. Inam has been ranked among the 32 most influential people in dentistry by Incisal Edge (#8) and received the Shils Innovator Award in 2022. She is also a member of the Santa Fe Group's Strategic Advisory Council, a think tank that advocates for better dental services.

DR. RENA N. D'SOUZA

Dr. Rena N. D'Souza is the director of the National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research. She oversees NIDCR's annual budget of more than \$475 million, which supports basic, translational, and clinical research in areas of oral cancer, orofacial pain, tooth decay, periodontal disease, salivary gland dysfunction, craniofacial development and disorders, and the oral complications of systemic diseases.

A licensed dentist, Dr. D'Souza is recognized for her research in craniofacial development, genetics, tooth development, and regenerative dental medicine. Prior to joining NIH, Dr. D'Souza was the Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs and Education for Health Sciences at the University of Utah, Salt Lake City. There she also served as a professor of dentistry, the Ole and Marty Jensen chair of the School of Dentistry and Professor of Neurobiology and Anatomy, Pathology and Surgery in the School of Medicine and the Department of Biomedical Engineering. In 2012, Dr. D'Souza was selected to be the inaugural dean of the University of Utah's School of Dentistry. She is a devoted mentor and champion of diversity in the biomedical research workforce. Since 1985, she has served as a volunteer dentist for women in need and people struggling with homelessness in Salt Lake City, Dallas, and Houston.

D'Souza received her Bachelor's Degree in dental surgery from the University of Bombay, India, after which she completed her general practice residency. She earned her DDS, PhD, and Master's Degree in pathology/biomedical sciences from the University of Texas Health Science Center in Houston.

DR. MARK S. WOLFF

Dr. Wolff has completed numerous international research and oral health assessment programs and has been a lifelong advocate and dental provider for individuals with physical, intellectual, and developmental disabilities of all ages. He has served as the principal or co-principal investigator on multiple benchtop and clinical research projects, investigating dental caries, novel remineralizing agents, dental erosion, periodontal disease, dental materials, and dentinal hypersensitivity. He has published over 100 scientific papers and text chapters and edited multiple textbooks. Dr. Wolff lectures worldwide and is a frequent consultant to the industry. He has been the principal or co-principal investigator on nearly \$9 million in both industrial research and funded research for the National Institutes of Health (NIH).


